How the program works

- Family selection
- In the program 12-18 months working towards homeownership
- Family classes
- Partnership hours and donated hours
- Variety of housing types
- Mortgage based on family income



Homeownership changes lives!

- Likelihood of graduating high school increases from 72% to 92%
- 116% better chance to attend college
- 50% better chance for a 4 year degree
- 40% less chance of teen pregnancy
- Net worth increases (avg) to \$105K from \$5K
- 74% report better health
- Almost without exception, asthma improves



Additional statistics:

- Habitat homeowners have paid over \$1.7 million in property taxes.
- Habitat has spent more than \$13 million to build, renovate, and repair homes.
- The direct economic impact of our building activity in this community exceeds \$86.9 million.
- The total assessed value of our investment in this community exceeds \$36.4 million.
- 75% of the families served are single parents
